## GENERAL INFORMATION

- The new U.S. Embassy is situated on an 11-acre site in the Leninsky District. The multi-building campus includes a chancery, Marine Security Guard residence, support annex, warehouse and facilities for the Embassy community.
- The new Embassy campus will provide a secure, modern, and environmentally sustainable workplace for visitors and Embassy staff.

## DESIGN

- The building meets all Department standards for security and provides modern office space for the embassy staff.
- The outdoor landscape includes native trees and winter-tolerant plants that complement the site topography.
- The office plan is open and provides flexibility for collaboration.
- Views of the mountainous terrain are enjoyed from the gallery and other common spaces.



## SUSTAINABILITY

- The project is registered with the U.S. Green Building Council for Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED®) certification and is projected to receive LEED® Silver certification.
- Water-conserving fixtures will be used, allowing the buildings to consume 30-40% less water than a comparably-sized building.
- The building is designed with energy efficient lighting, heating and HVAC systems.
- The building was built using materials containing high quantities of recycled content.



## CONSTRUCTION

- Construction started in November 2011 and final completion and dedication of a support annex and Marine Security Guard residence is underway.

## ART

- The building will feature contemporary sculpture, painting, and photography by artists from the United States and Kyrgyz Republic. To energize the work space, there will be site-specific installations created in harmony with the architecture.
- The art collection will emphasize the cultural parallels and intersections between the peoples of the United States and the Kyrgyz Republic.
