William D. Browning, Terrapin Bright Green LLC, received a Bachelor of environmental design from the University of Colorado and a MS in real estate development from MIT. In 1991, Browning founded Rocky Mountain Institute's Green Development Services, which was awarded the 1999 President's Council for Sustainable Development/Renew America Prize. In 2006 he became a principal in Terrapin Bright Green LLC, which crafts environmental strategies for corporations, government agencies and large-scale developments. Browning's clients include Walmart's Eco-mart, Starwood, Yellowstone National Park, Lucasfilm's Letterman Digital Arts Center, New Songdo City, Bank of America's One Bryant Park, the White House, and the Sydney

2000 Olympic Village. He coauthored *Green Development: Integrating Ecology and Real Estate*, *Green Developments (CD-ROM)*, *A Primer on Sustainable Building*, *Greening the Building and the Bottom Line*, and *The Economics of Biophilia*. Browning was named one of five people "Making a Difference" by *Buildings* magazine, and an Honorary member of the AIA. He was a founding member of US Green Building Council's Board of Directors, and is the Chair of the Greening America Board of Directors.
