Architect and MacArthur Fellow Jeanne Gang is Founder and Principal of Studio Gang Architects, an architectural practice noted for its innovation and leadership in design. Known for “challenging the aesthetic and technical possibilities of [architecture] in a wide range of structures,” Jeanne often arrives at design solutions through investigations and collaborations across disciplines. Her work has been honored and exhibited widely, most notably at the Venice Architecture Biennale, MoMA, the National Building Museum, and the Art Institute of Chicago. Her recent projects include the 82-story Aqua Tower (an Emporis Skyscraper of the Year); the Hyderabad 02 residential development for Hyderabad, India; the Nature Boardwalk at Lincoln

Park Zoo, an educational pavilion and landscape that also function as stormwater infrastructure; and the Arcus Center for Social Justice Leadership at Kalamazoo College, currently under construction, which will be the world’s first purpose-built structure for social justice leadership development.

A distinguished graduate of the Harvard Graduate School of Design, Jeanne has taught at Harvard, Yale, Princeton, and IIT, where her studios have focused on cities, ecologies, materials, and technologies. *Reveal*, her first volume on Studio Gang’s work and working process, was released in 2011 from Princeton Architectural Press.
